FALL 3RD YEAR

NURS 3068 COMMUNITY AND POPULATION HEALTH (required course). Clinical experience will have a focus in mental health.

WINTER 3RD YEAR

NURS 3145 ADVANCED THERAPEUTIC COMMUNICATION (replaces an elective course)

FALL 4[™] YEAR

NURS 4145 MENTAL HEALTH NURSING IN COMPLEX SITUATIONS (replaces an elective course)

WINTER 4TH YEAR

NURS 4153 PRECEPTORSHIP (required course) Preceptorship will have a mental health focus and can be across a variety of practice settings including primary care, community, acute care, public health, long term care and correction services.

To meet the growing needs for mental health nurses in New Brunswick, UNB Faculty of Nursing (Fredericton) has introduced a Mental Health Certificate (MHC) to support the development of advanced mental health skills and knowledge.

The MHC pathway combines both existing required and elective courses within the BN program to allow for a concentration and focus in mental health; additional courses are not required.

All students enrolled in the Bachelor of Nursing program in good academic standing are eligible to apply during Year 2 of studies.
