Receiving a Disclosure of Sexual Assault

Recent Sexual Assault (in the last 72 hours)

Ensure the safety of the individual

Offer Support

Let them know you are there to listen. Don't pressure them to talk about the assault. Ask how you can help the most. Do not voice your own opinion or judgments. Support and encourage their decisions.

It is important that the individual seeks **medical attention** to treat any physical injuries, test for STIs, get emergency contraceptive, and/or preserve any evidence if reporting the assault.

Is the individual interested in going to the emergency room?

Encourage the individual to seek medical attention soon. Refer to UNB Student Health Centre, family physician, or the Hospital

Arrange for transportation to the **Hospital**. When the individual arrives at the hospital, they will have the option of having an FSAC* volunteer support them through the process.

Does the individual want to report to the police? Or notify UNB Security?

Let them know you will be referring them to the Campus Sexual Assault Support Advocate (CSASA) for support. The individual can choose to refuse the support offered by the CSASA.

Tell survivor **NOT** to shower, brush teeth, or go to the bathroom if possible. Place clothes in a paper bag or pillow case

Encourage them to call on their own. If

they are incapable, call them yourself and

indicate what has happened.

Call the Campus Sexual Assault Support Advocate (CSASA) with name and phone number of student seeking support, as well as time and location of assault.

At all times make every effort to maintain the privacy of the individual
