### **1.0 Purpose**

- 1.1 To outline the University of New Brunswick's policy regarding the powers of the president regarding suspensions.

### **4.0 Implementation**

- 4.1 Notwithstanding the restriction in Section 59(1) (c) of the University of New Brunswick Act, the Board of Governors, pursuant to Section 51 of the Act, hereby authorizes the President, in cases of students found guilty of academic offences, to suspend such students for periods exceeding 60 days but not greater than two years. The exercise by the President of the above power is subject to the provisions of Section 59(2) of the Act.
