

# Accessing Office of the Registrar Services UNB Fredericton

On March 19, the Government of New Brunswick declared a state of emergency to enhance measures to help contain the spread of COVID-19. All public schools, universities and colleges will remain closed until further notice.

Public access to UNB campuses is restricted and all in-person service is suspended. The UNB Fredericton Registrar Office is offering virtual service to support student needs as course instruction moves to alternative methods of delivery.

## **Admissions**

- Electronic transcripts will be accepted for transfer credit (i.e. Off Campus Study).
- Electronic transcripts must be received directly from an email address of the sending institution.

## **Transcript services**

- UNB's Transcript ordering system remains open. Please note processing is suspended until March 30<sup>th</sup>. Delays can be expected.

- Due to the circumstances related to COVID-19 public access to UNB is restricted until further notice. Our transcript mail and fax services are closed. Transcript requests will be sent electronically to the recipient e-mail you provide on the online order form.
- Our office is processing requests remotely to support our students.

# Confirmation of enrolment letters

# Exam deferral requests

All students requesting to write an exam at an alternate time must submit a deferred exam request to the Registrar's Office using their personal <u>UNB eServices</u> account. Please note, no supporting medical documentation is required until further notice.



# Course extension requests

Please direct student requests for course extensions for term work to your course instructor. Term work extension requests do not require medical documentation.

Please direct any course withdrawal requests to <a href="mailto:records@unb.ca">records@unb.ca</a>. Requests must be sent from your UNB e-mail account and should include your student ID information and specific course withdrawal details.
