

## Planning for Fall 2021 Student COVID Accommodations

Revised: July 22, 2021

The majority of classes for Fall 2021 will include an in-person component. You are expected to be on campus to attend all in-person components of the courses as defined by course instructors and outlined in the [UNB course timetable](#).

It is imperative that we follow recommendations of Public Health for preventing communicable disease. These include washing your hands frequently, coughing into your elbow, continuing to physical distance when possible, staying at home when sick and getting tested when symptomatic.

We will continue to provide flexibility and accommodations for students unable to attend in-person if there is a documented concern such as travel restrictions and COVID related health conditions.

**IMPORTANT:** Accommodations may require alteration in course selection.

### Travel restrictions

If you have international travel concerns related to COVID, including travel bans and restrictions; flight availability or extremely prohibitive travel costs; or inability to meet requirements to enter Canada:

### COVID positive or required to self-isolate

If you are diagnosed with a communicable disease such as COVID or directed by New Brunswick Public Health to self-isolate for a period of time resulting in no in-person access to course components for four (4) weeks or less:

- Submit your request and documentation to your instructor.

### Chronic health conditions

If your health care provider recommends that you do not attend in-person classes for the duration of the term due to chronic health conditions related to COVID:
