# New Brunswick Critical Care Nursing Program (NBCCNP)

As part of its commitment to the recruitment and retention of nursing resources for New Brunswick, the Department of Health contributes to the preparation of nurses for the specialty of Critical Care Nursing through the Certificate of Critical Care Nursing. This program is offered in collaboration with the University of New Brunswick (UNB), l'Université de Moncton (U de M), and the New Brunswick Regional Health Authorities.

The NBCCNP is a standardized Critical Care Certificate program based on standards of the Canadian Association of Critical Care Nurses (CACCN), the National Emergency Nurses Affiliation (NENA), and the Canadian Council of Cardiovascular Nurses (CCCN).

The program includes both theory and practice and is delivered by distance; primarily online, but may also include audio or live virtual sessions, clinicals, and a preceptorship.

## SOFTWARE REQUIREMENTS

A Windows or Apple (Mac) computer with the following minimum software requirements is essential.

**Note:** Word processing and presentation software is required, such as Word and Powerpoint. Preferably Microsoft Office suite.

The program offers learning in both a critical care and emergency care environment. Courses may be offered at as many as eight sites depending on students' locations. It is offered in either official language.

The program consists of 7 courses including a 135-hour Integrated Clinical Practicum. It may be taken in one block full-time or if necessary, completed part-time within the same fiscal period (i.e., April 2018 - March 2019).

A non-credit Certificate of Proficiency will be granted upon successful completion of the program.

**Please Note:** This program is open to nurses employed by NB Health Authorities (Horizon or Vitalité) who are novice to critical or emergency care nursing (less than or equal to one year of experience in these practice areas) or are interested in pursuing a career in critical care or emergency care nursing.
