- a literary CV (the applicant should have at least one full-length work published and/or professionally performed)
- samples of work
- a letter of application describing the writing project and any particular public outreach to be undertaken during the residency (eg. a description of workshops to be offered)
- 2 letters of recommendation
- newspaper and magazine reviews if available
