The LWSO Minor consists of 24 ch of course work, including LWSO 2003. Students will choose an additional 21 ch from core and elective course lists. Of these, 9 ch shall be chosen from at least 2 disciplines (other than LWSO) among core courses. At least 18 ch shall be upper level courses (3000 level or above).

Double Major with _____

The LWSO major consists of 30 ch, which must include LWSO 2003 and LWSO 4003. Students will choose an additional 24 ch from core and elective course lists. Of these, 9 ch shall be chosen from at least 2 disciplines (other than LWSO) among core courses. Additional core courses may be counted as electives. At least 24 ch shall be upper level courses (3000 level or above).

Joint Honours with _____

Students intending to complete a Joint Honours program must apply in writing to a LWSO Coordinator for admission. Normally, students wishing to complete a Joint Honours will apply before the beginning of their 3rd year and will have a minimum GPA of 3.3 or B+. A Joint Honours consists of 36ch, including completion of all the requirements for the Double Major (above) and completion of either (a) 6 ch of 4000 level courses from core or elective lists, approved by the LWSO Coordinator, OR, (b) completion of LWSO 5000 Honours Thesis in Law in Society.

**NOTE: A grade of C or better is required for course credit in all LWSO programs.*
