**TRAVEL STUDY PROGRAM
AWARD APPLICATION**

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR AN AWARD, CANDIDATES MUST:

- Be an undergraduate UNB student in any faculty from either Fredericton or Saint John campus
- Be enrolled in a minimum of 4 courses or 12 credit hours per term in a UNB Degree Program
- Be in good academic standing with a minimum GPA of 2.0
- Have completed 12 credit hours of courses at UNB or at any other university, if you are a transfer student
- Both domestic and international students are eligible to apply, but preference will be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents of Canada
- Courses in the Travel Study Program must all be taken for credit
- Be in good financial standing: Prior to the end of winter term, all tuition fees must be paid in full in order to proceed with a Travel Study Program.
- Agree to speak on behalf of the Travel Study Program about your experience at future events.

With your application, you must submit:

- The name of one faculty member from whom a reference may be requested
- A letter of no more than 500 words explaining how you would benefit from receiving a Travel Study Award
- A copy of your UNB Transcript
- **Completed Travel Study application along with \$1000 deposit.**

Value & Number of the Travel Study Awards:

- For 2020, 10 awards worth \$1000 each will be available for students participating in the Paris Travel Study Program
 - Selection of students to receive these awards will be based primarily on students' academic achievement as demonstrated by students' cumulative grade point averages (CGPA) and the students' expression of how the course will benefit their career goals and program of study
 - Students who received Travel Study Awards in previous years will not be eligible for a current Travel Study award
