STUDENTS IN THE MAJOR AND HONOURS PROGRAMS IN CLASSICS, CLASSICAL STUDIES AND CLASSICAL ARCHAEOLOGY STREAM IN THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL INTERDEPARTMENTAL PROGRAM ARE ELIGIBLE.

One or more awards of up to \$3000 annually. This award will be given to one or more UNB student(s) in Classics and Ancient History on the Fredericton campus who has successfully completed at least two years or the equivalent (a minimum of 12 credit hours or equivalent) in Latin or Greek. The award is to be used for participation in an approved program of overseas summer study, archaeology or research, preferably in classical lands. It must be used within nine months of graduation. The award is to be made by the Department of Classics and Ancient History. The award has been established by Dr. Mary Ella Milham, Professor Emerita.

Students who meet the terms of the award may apply by submitting a brief description of the proposed summer study by December 6th, 2019, to the Chair.
