Program Notes

It may be possible to complete a concentration within your program. Possible areas are: counselling, early childhood education, First Nations education, literacy, math, science, second language education, social studies, exceptional learners. Courses under the elective and required subject/ methodology categories can be combined to form a concentration.

Two courses in literacy and/or numeracy education are recommended to provide a broader background in the area, but only one course in each is required.

NOTE: It is the student’s responsibility to ensure that he/she has met the requirements of the BEd degree (i.e. the appropriate 48 ch in Education course work plus the 12 ch in student teaching practica).

Please be aware that no grade lower than “C” will count for credit toward the Bachelor of Education degree.

NOTE: Elementary stream students pursuing the Certificate in Teaching English as a Second Language (CTESL) will require more than 60 ch to complete all program requirements.
