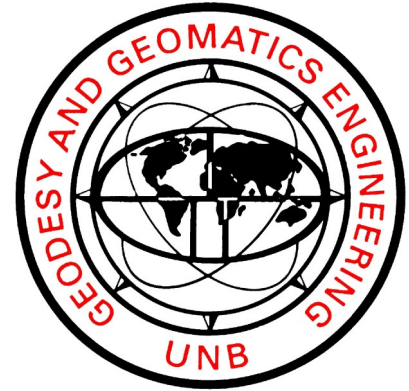

About the Speaker: Dr. Zhizhao (George) Liu is currently an Associate Professor in the Department of Land Surveying and Geo-Informatics (LSGI) at the Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU), Hong Kong. He received his BSc from Jiangxi University of Science and Technology, China, in 1994 and MSc from the Wuhan University, China, in 1997. He earned his PhD from University of Calgary in 2004. Before he joined the Hong Kong Polytechnic University in 2009, he worked as a Research Scientist in the GNSS industry based in Calgary. His research Lab, Micro-Laboratory of Atmospheric Research and Geomatics Engineering (Micro-LARGE), has a broad spectrum of research interests, including new algorithm development for precise Global Navigation Satellite System (GNSS), GNSS Precise Point Positioning (PPP), ionosphere modeling and scintillation monitoring, tropospheric modeling and GNSS meteorology.
