** Faculty Regulations 4(13)-4(21) set requirements for course loads and withdrawal from law courses. First-year students must be registered in all compulsory courses to remain in the program. First-year students who withdraw from the program voluntarily, even though prior to the date for academic penalty, must apply for re-admission to first-year in accordance with Faculty Regulations 7(1)-(5).
