Career Connect

Mitacs Career Connect is a wage subsidy program that supports six-month placements for organizations interested in hiring recent post-secondary graduates for jobs that protect the environment, create positive environmental outcomes, or address an environmental or climate change-related challenge.

How Career Connect works:

- Eligible company hires a graduate for 6 months, company chooses their graduate
- Student must be a graduate of post-secondary education (college, undergraduate, master's or PhD), be a Canadian Citizen, and under 30 years old
- Student applies a STEM skill (science, technology, engineering or math) in the job
- Company pays salary between \$20,000-\$25,000
- Mitacs reimburses company \$10,000 or \$12,500 (50% of intern's salary)

Eligible organizations:

- Sole proprietorships; for-profit organizations; non-profits, provincial and municipal government; universities and colleges; non-governmental organizations; and Indigenous organizations

Eligible sector areas:

- Natural resource sectors, including energy, forests, minerals and metals, and earth sciences
- The position should focus on protecting the environment, creating positive environmental outcomes, or addressing an environmental or climate change challenge.

Deadline to apply: Placements must start no later than January 1, 2019.
