



The 2020 UNBF Student Union Great Computer Give-Away

The UNBF Student Union has received *reconditioned* laptop computers from UNB Information Technology Services to be given away during the fall 2020 term. Please read rules and regulations below to determine program eligibility.

Due to the limited number of available “reconditioned” computers, program eligibility will not guarantee award.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility is restricted to **full-time UNBF undergraduate** students with **demonstrated** financial need. Students must also be in good academic standing (*GPA of 2.0 and over from the most recent assessment year*) to be eligible for program consideration.

PROCEDURES AND IMPLEMENTATION

Step 1:

Complete the attached budget sheet.

Budget sheet is obtainable through the UNBF Financial Aid Office located on the 1st Floor, CC Jones Student Services Centre or from the websites -

Step 2:

Complete the “Understanding and Consent Section” of the Great Computer Give-Away application before submitting complete application to the Financial Aid Office.

****Please note** that UNSIGNED applications will **NOT** be considered for the UNBF Student Union Great Computer Give-Away.

Step 3:

The Financial Aid Office (Fredericton Campus) will review “completed” applications and send a list of eligible applicants to the UNBF Student Union.

Step 4:

The UNBF Student Union will notify successful applicants by Friday, October 2nd, 2020.

Please Note: Due to the volume of applications, *only* the Great Computer Give-Away Winners (via email) will be contacted to confirm award.

DEADLINE: THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 24th, 2020

PLEASE BE ADVISED if you are selected as a recipient for the Great Computer Give-Away Program, you accept responsibility for obtaining the computer in-person from the Student Union.

The Fredericton Campus Student Union, Integrated Technology Services (ITS), and Financial Aid will **NOT** ship laptops or make arrangements for shipping.

RELEASE

WHEREAS The University of New Brunswick Student Union (the “Student Union”) and Information Technology Services (“ITS”) have agreed to gift reconditioned computer systems (the “Gift”) to those students as identified by the Student Union;

AND WHEREAS the undersigned releasor agrees to accept the Gift on an “as is where is” basis;

NOW THEREFORE WITNESS THAT:

I, _____ (name of student), of the Municipality of York County, in the City of Fredericton, (Hereinafter the “Releasor”, which term includes the heirs, administrators, executors and assigns of the Releasor), for good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, **DO HEREBY** remise, release and forever discharge any rights with respect to actions, causes of actions, debts, accounts, covenants, contracts, damages, special and general, claims and demands whatsoever which I have, ever had or which my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns hereinafter can, shall or may have for or by reason of any cause, matter or thing whatsoever existing up to the present time, against The Student Union or ITS (the “Releasee”) with respect to personal injury, loss and expenses sustained by the Releasor after and as a result of receiving, setting up and or using the Gift.

The Releasor acknowledges further that:

- a. program eligibility will not guarantee an award;
- b. the Financial Aid Office of the University of New Brunswick may review the Releasor’s academic transcript to verify academic standing;
- c. the Financial Aid Office may use the application form information to determine program eligibility;
- d. the information provided on the budget and/or application form is true to the best of the applicant’s knowledge;
- e. specific budget data and further financial information will not be released to The University of New Brunswick Student Union;
- f. if selected as a winner, the Releasor shall receive notice of such in writing and shall make immediate arrangements to obtain and/or collect the reconditioned computer; and
- g. in the event that the Releasor does not obtain or make arrangements for delivery/collection of the reconditioned computer within six months of receipt of the notice, The University of New Brunswick Student Union may deliver the reconditioned computer to another applicant.

AND FOR THE ABOVE CONSIDERATION, the Releasor further agrees not to make claim or take proceedings against the Releasee or against any other person or corporation which might claim contribution or indemnity under the provisions of any statute or otherwise against the Releasee, its successors and assigns.
