



THE GRADUATE STUDENT BURSARY PROGRAM 2020-2021

Graduate students (Masters/PhD) who are registered full-time at UNBF during the 2020-2021 academic year MAY be eligible for a *Graduate Bursary (maximum award \$500.00)*.

- ☀ Graduate Bursary Program resources are *very limited*.
- ☀ Please ensure all documentation has been supplied to properly assess your application-incomplete applications **cannot** be reviewed.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Graduate students (**inclusive of international/Canadian citizens/landed immigrants**).
2. Registered at UNB (*Fredericton Campus*) on a full-time basis (**September 2020-April 2021 inclusive**).

PROCEDURES

1. Complete a Graduate Bursary **application**.
2. **If applicable, INCLUDE** documentation confirming resources from all internal and/or external sources (i.e. scholarships, grants, sponsorship, fellowship, GRA/GTA, etc).
3. **If applicable, INCLUDE** a copy of your 2020-2021 student loan assessment from federal/provincial government student loan funding.
4. Complete a detailed **budget** for current academic year (September 1- April 30) listing your expenses, resources and anticipated shortfall (please see attached budget template).
5. Complete a detailed **letter** outlining/supporting your specific financial situation **including** any exceptional expenses and extenuating circumstances.

NOTIFICATION

1. All graduate bursary applicants will be notified through **e-mail by the end of January 2021**. Bursaries will be credited to your UNB student account by February 2021 and disbursed by UNB Financial Services (**located in the IUC Building**).
