## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Application deadlines vary depending on concentration:
  - PhD, exceptional learners, counselling = January 31
  - Educational administration and leadership, and curriculum studies = January 31, July 31
  - Critical studies, adult education and instructional design = three months prior to intended start date
- MEd applicants must hold a relevant undergraduate degree with a minimum GPA of 3.0 (B), and at least one year of relevant teaching or related professional experience
- Applicants must submit:
  - An online application
  - Letter of intent
  - Resumé
  - Three reference letters, including at least one academic letter if degree(s) have been completed in the last five years
  - Transcripts from all previous post-secondary education
- International applicants whose first language is not English must submit language scores
