Course Description:

Examine the nature of community and the concept and practice of community development in relation to sport and recreation behaviour and services. It reviews differing interpretations and approaches to community development and investigates current initiatives and projects that encourage citizen engagement and community mobilization. Identify potential problems and common strategies for addressing the challenges.

2. Grade multiple choice and short-answer questions on midterms.
