Instruction and laboratory work dealing with applications of Biology at the level of biological molecules and the cell. Pre or co-requisite: BIOL1001 or 1009.

Experience with PCR, gel electrophoresis and spectrophotometers is an asset. Preference will be given to those who have experience in a biology laboratory.
