Course Description:

Kin 4383 The study of the aging processes and the effects of exercise and lifestyle factors on the health and fitness of the aging adult. Students will receive theoretical knowledge and will apply that knowledge to real life situations. Students will learn common fitness tests for older adults and will test and interpret fitness levels of older adults.

Responsibilities:

1. A one-hour TA meeting during the first week of classes to establish the TA schedule, complete required paperwork and all for discussion related to the TA responsibilities for the course.
2. Providing feedback on short assignments that students complete based on readings. Feedback is designed to improve critical thinking skills and improve students' ability to demonstrate their learning
3. Assist instructor in proctoring tests/exams when possible
