Course Description:

Explore sport, physical activity, and leisure as social phenomena and important aspects of modern society. Examine many of the same sociological issues within the framework of sport, physical activity, and leisure that exist in society as a whole. More specifically, consider the cultural aspects of sport, physical activity and leisure, how they are related to social institutions (such as education, politics, and economics) and how they affect and are affected by social inequalities.

Responsibilities:

1. A one-hour TA meeting during the first week of classes to establish the TA schedule, complete required paperwork and all for discussion related to the TA responsibilities for the course.
2. Providing feedback on short assignments that students complete based on readings. Feedback is designed to improve critical thinking skills and improve students' ability to demonstrate their learning.

Knowledge and Desired Skills:

1. Candidate must have an educational background in the field of sport, recreation, or leisure.
2. Due to the one-week turnaround time for assignments, the candidate will have strong time management skills.
3. Strong record keeping abilities to manage lab/tutorial attendance, as well as grades.
