## **Healthy Toddler Assessment Database Reference Guide**

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### **Overview**

The Healthy Toddler Assessment (HTA) database is a provincial database on early health screening for New Brunswick children aged 16 to 24 months. Data is collected by the department of health using HTA questionnaires administered by public health nurses. The database contains data on dental, vision, hearing and safety as well as child development, growth, nutrition and immunizations. Parent literacy and depression data is also included.

Parents of 16-24 month-olds are invited to bring their children in for voluntary assessment. A public health nurse assesses the child's growth, development, nutrition, as well as the teeth, vision and hearing. The parents are also assessed for risk of depression and literacy challenges, and advised on child safety, vaccinations and accident prevention

The New Brunswick Institute for Research Data and Training (NB-IRD) holds an anonymized, linkable version of this data which provides project specific datasets with further scrambled identifiers to researchers.

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### **General methodology**

The Healthy Toddler Assessment (HTA) database contains anonymized data on results of health assessment questionnaires offered to all children in New Brunswick aged 16 to 24 months and their families. The public health nurse evaluates various aspects of the child's growth and development including physical skills, language development, social and personal relationships, as well as dental, vision and hearing. This data from the Department of Health is stored securely by the NBIRD for authorized access to researchers.

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### **Tool version**

TOOL\_VERSION\_NB: This is the version of the assessment that was used. Whenever questions are added/deleted/changed a new version of the tool is created.

Changes: Version 1 to Version 2

- Questions 6.1-6.8, 10.1-10.7, 14.1-14.6, 18.1-18.8 were added to version 2. In version 1 users only recorded answers to the lead questions (e.g. Child has risk of dental caries?) but were not required to record the answers to the specific questions.
- Question 163 – Method of reporting percentile ranges for some of the growth measurements were updated in line with changes made at the national level.
- Question 165 – Method of assessing that the child is up-to-date on their immunizations for the purpose of the HTA changed.

## 7. Ages & Stages Questionnaires (ASQ) Basic Information

The Ages & Stages Questionnaires® (ASQ-3™): A Parent-Completed Child Monitoring System. Third Edition. The purpose of the ASQ-3 is to screen and monitor a child's general development. The screening tool identifies children who need a more extensive assessment from those that do not. ASQ-3 is composed of twenty-one (21) questionnaires. In the Healthy Toddler Assessment they relate to children between the ages of sixteen (16) months to twenty-four (24) months. Each questionnaire has thirty (30) questions that assess five (5) areas of development: Communication, Gross Motor, Fine Motor, Problem solving, and Personal-Social. Each area comprises six (6) questions that progress from more simple behaviours or skills to more complex ones.

## 19. Parent Mental Health Information

The Edinburgh Postnatal Depression Scale (EPDS) is used by Public Health service providers to identify women who may be at risk of depression in the postpartum period. More recently, the EPDS tool has been used during pregnancy, beyond twelve (12) months postpartum, and has been found to be effective at identifying men at risk of depression. The EPDS consists of ten (10) short statements. A score of twelve (12) or above may reflect a depressive illness of varying severity. A score just below the cut-off point (eleven and below ≤11) should not be taken to indicate absence of depression.
