

Early Years Evaluation – Direct Assessment (Francophone Sector) ED03F

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About this Codebook

This reference guide is intended for users of the Early Years Evaluation (EYE-DA) (Francophone Sector) (PD0043F) data set, provided by the New Brunswick Department of Education and Early Childhood Development (EECD). This guide provides an overview of the data, the general methodology used in its creation, and important technical information, such as table and field descriptions. The development of this document is an ongoing process and will receive updates when changes occur in the EYE-DA database.

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Overview

The Early Years Evaluation (EYE-DA) (Francophone Sector) data set contains assessment results measuring a child's readiness to enter the education system. Included are measurements of a child's awareness of self and environment, cognitive skills, language and communication skills, physical development, and fine and gross motor skills.

Each assessment gives either a Green, Yellow, or Red outcome. The Green outcome indicates Appropriate development or "your child's development in this area is typical for children of a similar age". The Yellow outcome indicates Experiencing some difficulty or "your child would benefit from additional experiences in this area". The Red outcome indicates Experiencing significant difficulty or "your child would benefit from additional experiences in this area, and may require further assessment and on-going support". There are also outcomes of Not complete where "your child did not complete enough items in the domain to provide a result". About this Product

Purpose of the Product

The purpose of the Early Years Evaluation (Francophone Sector) ED03F Database Codebook is to provide information on the linkable data regarding the readiness of children starting school in New Brunswick. This data is held at the New Brunswick Institute for Research, Data and Training (NB-IRDT) and is accessible to researchers. It is particularly relevant for research topics pertaining to education, employment, public policy, and population dynamics.

Definitions and Concepts

Early Years Evaluation (EYE-DA) – The Early Years Evaluation (EYE-DA)/Évaluation de la petite enfance (ÉPE) is an assessment tool that aims to identify a child's strengths and weaknesses in order to support their learning and transition to school. It has two components:

- The Direct Assessment (DA)/Appréciation directe (ÉPE-AD)

Direct Assessment (EYE-DA) – The Direct Assessment is conducted by the child's family and the school district (or a contracted third party) between the child's enrollment and start of their first year of school (kindergarten). The assessment includes items relating to Awareness of Self and Environment, Cognitive Skills, Language and Communication, and Physical Development (Fine and Gross Motor Skills).

Awareness of Self and Environment – A child's understanding of the world and their ability to make connections with home and community experiences

Cognitive Skills – A child's basic math and pre-reading skills and their ability to solve problems

Language and Communication – A child's understanding of spoken language and their ability to express thoughts and feelings

Physical Development – A child's ability to perform fine (small) and gross (large) movements

Social Skills and Approaches to Learning – A child's attentiveness during classroom activities and their ability to interact with peers while respecting the classroom

Content

The EYE-DA database contains assessment results measuring a child's readiness to enter the education system. The data include measurements of a child's Awareness of Self and Environment, Cognitive Skills, Language and Communication, and Physical Development (Fine and Gross Motor Skills).



General Methodology

The EYE-DA data contain variables collected during assessments that occur between a child's enrollment and start of their first year of school (kindergarten).

Limitations

The Early Years Evaluation (Francophone Sector) PD0043F data contains variables related to the Direct Assessment (EYE-DA-DA) but excludes those pertaining to Teacher Assessments (EYE-DA-TA). The data is further limited to institutions from the Francophone sector.

Comparison to Other Products/Versions

The Early Years Evaluation (Anglophone Sector) PD0043E data set is complementary to the data from the Francophone Sector. Together, they form a complete data set for the province.

Using with Other Products

EYE-DA data may be linked with other NB-IRDT data sets through scrambled identifiers. However, the utility of such linkages may be limited by the range of available data.

DH10 – Citizen Database – The Citizen Database is a longitudinal data set of individuals living in New Brunswick, based on their eligibility for provincial Medicare. The Citizen Database contains information related to family structure, which may yield interesting results when parents' information is associated with their child's linked EYE-DA data.

ED03a – Early Years Evaluation (Anglophone Sector) – EYE-DA data is also available from the Anglophone Sector and can be combined with the complementary Francophone sector data to form an exhaustive provincial data set.
