**TIER 2 CANADA RESEARCH CHAIR**

The Department of Psychology at the University of New Brunswick is inviting applications for one NSERC Tier 2 Canada Research Chair (CRC) at the Assistant or Associate Professor level in language development. Individuals with expertise in bilingual language development or reading processes across the lifespan are particularly encouraged to apply. The appointment can start as early as October 2018 but no later than July 2019.

Applicants are expected to have a PhD in psychology, use cutting-edge experimental methods (e.g., eye tracking, event-related potentials, magnetic resonance imaging, behavioural assessment) in their research, and have an outstanding research record. The successful candidate will be expected to teach courses in language development, neuroscience, or cognition at the undergraduate or graduate level, supervise student research, and secure funding for their research.

Tier 2 chairs are intended for exceptional emerging scholars (i.e., candidates must have been an active researcher in their field for fewer than 10 years at the time of nomination), acknowledged by their peers as having the potential to lead in their field. Potential applicants who are more than 10 years from having earned their highest degree, and where career breaks exist, such as maternity, parental or extended sick leave, clinical training, etc., and/or where applicable exceptional circumstances are present, may have their eligibility for a Tier 2 chair assessed through the CRC Program's [Tier 2 justification process](#).
