2018-19 Performance Objectives Outcomes Report

In 2018-19, the Research Support Fund (RSF) Program funds allowed UNB to grow research competitiveness by investing in its research capacity and research support. The Incremental Projects Grants (IPG) funding is a stream of the RSF program that provides further support for the indirect costs of research. The IPG funding was invested into two projects, research policy development and renewal of lab facilities.
