## Programme Spotlight: Canadian Rivers Institute

The Canadian Rivers Institute (CRI) is based at UNB at both Saint John and Fredericton campuses, with Fellows also located at the University of Prince Edward Island, Université du Québec, Wilfred Laurier University, and at research nodes in Pinawa, Manitoba and Kelowna, British Columbia. The CRI offers multi-disciplinary research, provides training and outreach focusing on rivers and the challenges of water resources conservation, protection, restoration, and sustainable use.

The CRI has recruited internationally respected researchers dedicated to developing aquatic science which is needed to understand, protect and sustain water resources in Canada and abroad. We are the home to 6 Canada Research Chairs, have 15 Fellows, and 50 Canadian and international Associates. We are proud to have more than 100 highly qualified graduate students, postdoctoral fellows and research scientists who study and work directly with our Fellows and Associates. We have also attracted a high-caliber staff that makes our research possible.

The CRI places a significant emphasis on the education and training of undergraduate students, graduate students & postdoctoral fellows in river sciences. We provide courses and field-based training led by our Fellows and many Associate Fellows across our partnering institutions. The CRI experience gives students and postdoctoral fellows an opportunity to receive world-class training from leading experts in the field of river science, and the potential to develop long-term professional relationships.

### UNB Saint John CRI

At UNB Saint John, the CRI focuses on the environmental impacts of industrial and agricultural operations with an Ecosystem Health Assessment Laboratory (Dr. Kelly Munkittrick, Biology), a Fish Reproductive Physiology and Ecotoxicology Laboratory, and the Chemical Contamination of Food Webs Research Laboratory (Dr. Karen Kidd-Biology).

### UNB Fredericton CRI

At UNB Fredericton, the emphasis is primarily on aquatic ecology and engineering through the New Brunswick Cooperative Fish and Wildlife Research Unit and Benthic Macroinvertebrate Laboratory (Dr. Allen Curry, Biology, Forestry & Environmental Management), Stable Isotopes in Nature Laboratory (Dr. Rick Cunjak, Biology), Laboratory for Mitigating Impacts of Hydroelectric Development (Dr. Stephan Peake, Biology), Sediment Dynamics Research Laboratory (Dr. Katy Haralampides, Civil Engineering), and Groundwater Studies Group (Dr. Kerry MacQuarrie, Civil Engineering).

Federal partners have co-located the Environment Canada's National Water Research Institute's Centre for Multi-stressor Effects on Aquatic Biodiversity (Drs. Joseph Culp & Donald Baird) and the Gulf of St. Lawrence Estuaries Research Group of Fisheries and Oceans Canada, Gulf Region (Dr. Simon Courtenay) on the UNB Fredericton campus.
