

Before completing 2 years of full-time study, you must choose at least 2 term-courses in **three** of the four groups at the 1000 and 2000 level. Most students will complete this requirement in the first year.

Normal load: 5 courses per term = 10 term-courses per academic year
10 term-courses x 4 years = 40 term-courses
