- 4. Print a copy of your transcript (available through "My UNB E-services" found on the UNB homepage at www.unb.ca. Click on the Academic tab and on the left hand side click on Unofficial transcript).
- 5. Cross off any failed courses (F's), withdrawals (W's), Labs, and any course completed more than once, leaving the course with the best grade.
- 6. On Page 1, list the required courses for your Honours/Major/Double Major and/or Minor program on the chart FIRST.
- 7. List the remainder of your courses, in the proper column.
- 8. Continue with Page 2
- 9. Take this form and a copy of your transcript with you when you see your Honours, Major, Double Major, and/or Minor Advisor(s) for review, comments and signature.

Important Things to Note:

- This form should include the courses that you are registered in for the current academic year.
- You will not receive credit for courses you have passed twice. The duplicate course with the highest grade will be considered toward your degree.
- Labs are not considered courses in the BA degree.
