PARKING ON CAMPUS? THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

POLICY

UNB is private property and is able to regulate vehicle and pedestrian traffic through regulations approved by the Board of Governors. Enforcement is conducted by UNB Security. Any accidents should be reported to UNB Security. The University can prohibit anyone from parking or passing through campus. Any vehicle which is left stationary for more than 14 days can be removed at owners expense and risk.

PERMITS

Permits are license plate based and may be purchased online at **UNB.ca/security/parking**

More than one vehicle may be registered, but please remember to ensure you have your permit showing as active on the correct vehicle.

GENERAL


Vehicles must be parked in designated areas in accordance with the type of permit. Do not park on the grass, sidewalks, fire lanes or obstruct roadways. The absence of a 'No Parking' sign does not mean an area is OK to park in.

From December 1st to March 31st the Winter Parking Regulations are in effect on the Fredericton campus to allow for snow clearing. Vehicles on Campus after hours must be moved to designated storm lots.

FINES/TOWING

Your vehicle may be "booted" or towed at your risk if parked in violation of the regulations, has repeated offences, or outstanding fines assigned to it. Failure to pay fines can result in parking privileges being revoked or, for students, having the amount assigned to your student account. Fines can be paid online through HotSpot.

APPEALS

An appeal will be considered in the following circumstances only:

- (i) the violation was issued contrary to the regulations;
- (ii) it was issued in error;
- (iii) proof of extenuating circumstances.

PERMIT FEES
